**Council Meeting  
18 June 2012**

Ms. Swaney called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

**Roll Call:** Linda Swaney – Yes, Craig Ronyak – No, Jeff Coleman – No, Dianne Lillibridge – Yes, Charles Hauser – Yes, Brian Johnston – Yes.

**Old Business:**

Ms. Swaney brought up the topic of Street Striping and asked Mr. Hauser to explain. Mr. Hauser related that the vendor awarded the street striping contract this year, GAW Enterprises, has withdrawn his bid and will no longer be doing work in the Village. Another company, Ronyak Street Painting, was contacted and has agreed to paint all the striping areas in the Village for the sum of \$5,350. Mr. Johnston discussed with Council the possibility of having Village employees do the striping themselves. Mr. Hauser agreed that it was a good idea and will look into it for next year. Given the late date, Mr. Hauser asked that for this year the Ronyak Company be accepted. Mr. Hauser moved to accept the bid of \$5350 from Ronyak Painting. Mrs. Lillibridge seconded the motion. Roll Call: Charles Hauser – Yes, Dianne Lillibridge – Yes, Brian Johnston – Yes, Linda Swaney – Yes. Motion passed.

Ms. Swaney informed those present that the Community Development Block Grant request for the ADA bathrooms at the log cabin had not been funded. The grant predominantly went to Huntsburg Township.

The Village application for Issue I funds at the State level for the Goodwin Hickox Street project was not given grant funding because of it being considered affordable under state guidelines. The Village could, however, apply for a low or no interest loan. Council discussed and Mr. Hauser recommended that no action be taken to obtain a loan. Council agreed and issue went no further.

Mr. Hauser moved to adjourn and Mr. Johnston seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 6:45 PM.
