

Welton Cemetery Meeting Minutes

December 11, 2014

Ms. Kimpton called the meeting to order at 3:00 PM

Roll Call: Marcianne Kimpton-present, Newell Beaumier-present, Arleen Richardson-absent

Clerks Report:

Mr. Beaumier made a motion to accept the minutes of October 22, 2014, Ms. Kimpton seconded. By voice all Board Members agreed.

Discussion:

Ms. Pikus brought to the attention of the Board that there was a burial that took place on Wednesday November 26th, 2014 and she was unsure of the fee for the burial. It was an unusual circumstance for the Cemetery. Mr. Ruble's wife's cremains were disinterred and she was reburied with Mr. Ruble's cremains in a large cremation urn. Ms. Pikus wanted the board to discuss a price for this type of burial. After discussion, Mr. Beaumier made a motion, inclusive with Mr. Ruble's burial and this point forward to charge \$380.00 to disinter a large or small cremation urn plus a \$150.00 for the reburial of the disinterred cremains. The interment of the "new" cremains burial would follow the Welton Cemetery cremation burial fee schedule in place. Ms. Kimpton seconded. By voice, all board members agreed.

Ms. Pikus presented a price sheet from Mr. Szuskiewicz. Mr. Szuskiewicz raised his foundation prices by \$10.00 per foundation. Mr. Beaumier made a motion to accept Mr. Szuskiewicz prices and raise all foundation prices by \$10.00 on the Welton Cemetery price list starting January 1, 2015, Ms. Kimpton seconded. By voice all members agreed.

Ms. Kimpton made a motion to charge \$25.00 to transfer a deed and \$5.00 per copy starting January 1, 2015. Mr. Beaumier seconded. By voice all agreed.

The Cemetery Fence is completed and Mr. Beaumier requested that Ms. Pikus get quotes on signage for the entrance and exit.

Ms. Pikus noted that the mailbox for the cemetery has been installed by the Street Department and the Rules and Regulations are easily accessible for the Public.
