

Welton Cemetery Meeting Minutes

October 18, 2017

Ms. Kimpton called the meeting to order at 11:00 AM.

Clerks Report:

Ms. Kimpton made a motion to accept the September 20, 2017 minutes, seconded by Ms. Richardson. By voice vote, the motion passed.

Old Business:

The Cemetery sign is still not up. Ms. Kimpton has not been able to reach Dave Brent, who is restoring the sign. Ms. Kimpton will attempt to speak with him again.

Ms. Kimpton reminded the Board that they would not be meeting again until next April, possibly next May, unless circumstances arose that necessitated a meeting.

Mr. Beaumier said that Mrs. Judy Beaumier will repaint the gold eagles on the Veteran's memorial at the Cemetery.

New Business:

The Welton Cemetery Board would like to recognize the stellar efforts of Mr. Alex Hansel, on behalf of Welton Cemetery, and thank him for his service, as he prepares to leave the Village and take on a new employment opportunity.

Mrs. Judy Beaumier suggested that the Cemetery Board should send a card of thanks to Mr. Hansel. Mrs. Kimpton will pick up a card and bring it to the office to be sent out.

Ms. Kimpton updated the Board on her recent meeting with Jim Szuskiewicz regarding repairing/replacing footers in the Cemetery. Ms. Kimpton and Mr. Szuskiewicz decided that three footers needed to be replaced this year, at a cost of \$650 for all three. Ms. Kimpton made a motion to authorize Mr. Szuskiewicz to replace these footers at a cost of \$650. Seconded by Ms. Richardson. By voice vote, the motion passed.

Ms. Kimpton would like the Street Department to remove all of the live flowers in the planters at the Cemetery, as the season has passed, and they are no longer thriving. Ms. Kimpton has also asked the Street Department to remove a tree that appears to be failing.

Mr. Beaumier moved to adjourn and Ms. Richardson seconded. By voice vote, the motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 11:23 am.
