## **Bulk Item Collection Service** Must be called in, scheduled and paid for in advance 24 hrs.

Waste Management will also collect bulk items during your scheduled day once scheduled and paid in advance. If the truck picking up your regular waste leaves the bulk trash, we will dispatch a second truck to retrieve these larger items. We ask that you be patient. Bulk items are objects too large for one person to handle, and typically include the following:

- Carpet Please cut, roll and tie the carpet in lengths no greater than four feet.
- Appliances Please remove appliance doors and freon.
- Large Screen TVs (42 inches and up)
- Furniture
- Mattresses, box springs and cloth furniture **wrapped in plastic with duct tape** to ensure the safety of our people due to bed bug outbreaks.
- Lumber Products Please bundle and tie wood products in lengths no longer than three feet and weight of 40 lbs.
- Items more than 100 lbs. must be called in by the resident to schedule a separate pickup.

## Service Levels

Standard Service - Weekly trash collection with 96-gallon cart provided and every other week recycle service with 64-gallon cart provided \$16.50 per month

Senior Service for those 65 and older - Weekly trash collection with 96-gallon cart provided and every other week recycle service with 64gallon cart provided \$15.65 per month. Senior verification form must be filled out at Village Hall.

#### **Bag service**

- Roll of 5 bags can be purchased at Village Hall for \$15.00
- Must use the specific blue Color bag that is just for Burton Village
- Orange WM bags will not be picked up in the Village limits past August 1

#### Automated Trash Collection Program for Burton Village

Trash and recycling will now be collected throughout the entire Village with an automated truck. To collect your trash it must be in the cart provided by Waste Management. If you wish to get rid of your old trash cans place them inside the cart or mark them with tape to be taken away on trash day.

### Cart Delivery

- Current customers of WM that have a cart that is NOT GREEN will receive a Green 96-gallon trash cart
- a 64-gallon recycle cart

### Waste Collection Guidelines

As residents of the Village of Burton, you will receive residential waste collection once per week. Please observe the following guidelines to keep your collection service running smoothly. • Bag and tie your trash inside the 96 gallon cart.

## Placing Your Cart Out for Collection

Moving one cart at a time, first, make sure the lid is closed. Then grab the handle and use the convenient "tilt and qo" bar feature (between the wheels at the rear of the cart), to tilt the cart back slightly. Now, safely and easily push or pull the cart. The cart is designed to withstand dragging, however, for ease of use, tilt and roll! DON'T FORGET: Always close the lid before moving. Pull the cart uphill, and push the cart downhill.

• Paint cans with wet paint residue

- Residents that are not currently a WM customer will receive a Green 96-gallon trash cart
- All current and new customers signed up for standard or senior service levels will receive
- The carts will be delivered to the end of your drive way
- All cart deliveries and exchanges will be completed by March 29th

• Place your trash cart within three feet of the curb in front of your residence the night before your scheduled collection day with the lid opening facing the street.

• Cart is to be completely full. NO items outside of cart.

Your cart should be placed out at the curb by 6:30 a.m. on your scheduled collection day. Your cart should be placed three feet from the roadway with the handles facing toward your home and the lid opening toward the street. Do not place your cart in the street.

# Do not place your cart close to obstructions such as mailboxes, utility poles, fire

Always keep the lid closed to keep animals, rain, snow, and ice out, and keep the refuse, recyclables and odors in.





## **Pick Up Schedule**

#### The entire Village will be serviced on Friday

- PLACE YOUR CARTS OUT BY 6:30 A.M.
- FILL YOUR CART FIRST. Cart must be filled completely with trash and or yard waste, no extra cans or bags may be placed outside the cart.



Cart must be filled. NO extra cans or bac are placed outside the cart.

- Place the front opening towards the street and the wheels toward your home.
- Please keep a minimum of 3 feet of space between cart and other items.

- Keep space between objects and carts.
- Objects and cart are too close together.
- Carts must be within 3 feet of the curb.
- Please do not park your car in front of cart on pick up day.
- Do not place your cart close to obstructions such as mailboxes.



• Please put your recycling cart out on the other side of your driveway from your trash cart with the lid opening facing the street, if possible.

#### Remove Your Cart After Collection

In order to help maintain the appearance of your neighborhood, please remove your cart promptly after having been serviced. If possible the cart should be stored inside of a garage. Be careful not to store your cart close to a furnace, fireplace, grill or other source of excessive heat.

#### **Caring for Your Carts**

The trash cart is designed for ease of maintenance. To clean, simply rinse with water from time to time and let it dry in sunlight with the lid open. Do not place paints, solvents, acids, gasoline, oil, hot ashes, medical, exposed needles, sand, soil, rocks or concrete in your cart.
