

Burton Village Council Meeting
Minutes
May 10, 2021

Mayor Spanos called the meeting to order at 7 PM.

Visitors: Jennell Dahlhausen, Ann Wishart, Pete Spanos.

Roll Call:

Mr. Boehnlein moved to approve the minutes of April 26, 2021, seconded by Mr. Blair. By voice vote, the motion passed.

Mayors Report

Mayor Spanos attended the Claridon Township meeting with Mr. Boehnlein and Ms. Dahlhausen. The Trustees had interest in meeting with the other entities to discuss a Tax District.

Fiscal Officers Report

Ms. Dahlhausen is preparing the 2022 Tax Budget and will need to hold a Public Hearing at an upcoming meeting. Council agreed to hold the Public Hearing Monday, June 21 at 7 PM.

Mr. Blair moved to pay approved invoices, seconded by Ms. Richards. By voice vote, the motion passed.

Ordinances and Resolutions

Mayor Spanos placed on first reading, Ordinance 2406-21 to amend Chapter 913 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Burton regarding the Tree Commission.

Old Business

Mr. Boehnlein stated he is not satisfied with Arborist for the village and stated she is not upholding her contract by updating the Tree Tracker software as specified. Ms. Richards will speak with her and ask her to attend the next Council meeting.

New Business

Council would like to meet with Burton and Claridon Township to discuss the Tax District further on May 24 or 27 or June 7, 8 or 10. Ms. Dahlhausen will call everyone with the dates.

Public Participation

Mr. Spanos attended the meeting to express that he was disappointed that Council adopted Resolution 2021-17 to declare and reaffirm support of the Second Amendment of the United States Constitution and Article 1, Section 4 of the Ohio Constitution. He said he feels there are other issues that he feels are more important such as organ donation or supporting COVID19 vaccinations, and added he feels Council supporting this topic is tricking the public into paranoia.

Mr. Boehnlein moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Blair. By voice vote the motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 7:20 PM.
