New Business:

Former Berkshire School Lot Split:

Ms. Piotrowski informed Planning Commission the former Berkshire High School and former football field are have connected service lines that should have been disconnected during the lot split. Mr. Gruber mentioned that when Mr. Blair came upon the Planning Commission to sell the former Berkshire High School, there was no discussion on service lines being connected to the former football field.

Wedding in the Gazebo-Fee:

Ms. Piotrowski informed Planning Commission that a resident came to ask permission to use the Gazebo in January 2023 for a wedding ceremony. The Village of Burton gazebo permit does not have a deposit for the use of the gazebo. Mr. Johnson recommended a small for fee for using the gazebo for a wedding ceremony for \$25. Mr. Johnson suggested if the wedding will be bigger than just a ceremony with food trucks, etc then the deposit should be \$500.

Old Business:

Food trucks on public property:

Ms. Piotrowski mentioned to Planning Commission that Southern Charm food truck has been parking by Undercover Charm for the past three Saturdays. Mr. Brown clarified that in our Village of Burton ordinance its states they can park in public parking 12 times a year and Southern Charm should not meet that by the end of 2022.

Mr. Schaner expressed his concerns about the food trucks and making sure the other businesses are fully aware of the food truck policies. Mr. Schaner suggested to Planning Commission about the abbreviation "DORA" which means Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area" for adult beverages. Mr. Schaner suggested looking into Shaker Heights since they do "DORA" for events in the city.
