Old Business:

Food trucks on public property:

Mayor Spanos would like to move forward with amending food trucks into the Village of Burton ordinance. Mr. Brown suggested to have designated times and have special events for food trucks to come to the Village of Burton. Ms. Wayman spoke her concern about the food trucks coming in to the Village, while the businesses that are already here are struggling to keep their business going. Ms. Wayman said that having food trucks in the village would deter customers away from their business, since the food trucks will be in town selling bake goods, lunch, dinner, and coffee.

Mr. Brown mentioned what attracts most people to the Village of Burton is tourists attraction, which brings in business for the local businesses. Mayor Spanos suggested promoting the restaurants in Burton to bring in more customers in Geauga County. Mr. Gruber mentioned 729.03 in the Village of Burton Ordinance mentions peddler, canvassing, and itinerant vendor within the Village without first obtaining a license.

Mayor Spanos suggested food vendors are not allowed in public areas without it being a special event. Mr. Hicks mentioned residential properties could have food trucks since it will be a private event with no permit. Mr. Hicks mentioned the guidelines for business district would be getting a permit, permit fee, a copy of their license from the Geauga County Health Department, and limiting to 12 days a year. Mayor Spanos confirmed that the events the Chamber of Commerce hosts in the park would not need to get a food truck permit from the village.
