

## WELTON CEMETERY MEETING MINUTES

Mr. Gingerich acknowledged the work and time frame and will do what he can to have this corrected quickly. Mrs. Erickson and Mrs. Richardson would appreciate if the cemetery was up and functional before Memorial Day.

Mrs. Arnold inquired if the board would like to add any benches at the cemetery for people to be able to sit down if need be. Mrs. Richardson and Mrs. Erickson will drive to the cemetery to look around at specific areas as well as look at the urns. Mrs. Richardson would like to verify the urns do not need to be painted as they were painted last year in 2024.
