**Patrol Officer Minimum Qualifications**

- Must Possess a valid Ohio Driver's License
- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Must be at least 21 years old at time of appointment
- United States Citizen
- Criminal record free of felony convictions or other crimes of aggression, violence or moral turpitude.
- Basic Ohio Police Officer Training Academy with current OPOTA certification required at time of appointment
